BUS SAFETY Rules

To ensure bus safety, the BUS MONITORS will



Not use mobile phones for personal business



Check seatbelts, and the First Aid kits before each departure



Follow the bus schedule.
Bus will not wait for more than
2 mins



Step off the bus to assist students getting on and off



Ensure all students enter the school campus



Report all bus issues to the Bus Coordinator

BUS SAFETY Rules

To ensure bus safety, the BUS DRIVERS will



Not smoke on the bus



Only use the bus which has Renaissance logo



Put the signage "CHILDREN ON BUS" at the front of the bus when students are on the bus



Check the bus and switch the "CHILDREN ON BUS" signage to "CHECKED AND EMPTY" after all students get off



Pull over safely if distracted by misbehaviors



Abide by the reduced speed limit in school zones and at bus stops



Stop and turn off the bus engine when arriving at school



Not park on passenger crossing



Close the bus door and ensure all students are seated before moving

BUS SAFETY Rules

To ensure bus safety, when on the bus, STUDENTS will



Be quiet and only use indoor voices



Wear a seatbelt while the bus is moving



Follow intruction of the Bus Monitor



Not eat or drink on the bus (except pure water)



Keep windows closed. Keep head, hands, arms inside the bus



Make sure clothing toggles and drawstrings are not left dangling

To ensure bus safety, when getting off the bus, STUDENTS will



Hold the handrail as you comedown the steps



Take large steps away from the bus. If you drop something near the bus, do not pick it up. Signal the Bus Monitor for assistance
